

Casting Resin Bags

Instruction

 Plastics and metals must be dry and free of oil and grease before pouring resin.

 The resin must not come into contact with moisture or water befire curing.



For ambinet temperatures below 100 C: warm the bag to about 200 C before mixing.



Remove polyethelen bag. remove rubber and plastic seal from center of bag.

Mix contents by kneading vigorously for 3 minutes.









Make certian all resin is squeezed from the corners and edges the bag.



Immediately after mixing push all resin to one half of the bag. Twist bag to separate empty and full parts of bag.



Immediatley pour the resin in the mould.



Hold the full part of the bag in one hand and remove a corner of the bag.

Attention

- $A) When {\it closing joint for connecting cables}, cable {\it cover using sandpaper}, to be {\it perfectly clean}.$
- B) Bag package permits to mix the resin without touching, in case it happens rub it off with soap.
